



FAQ -- Recall Carhartt Infant 2-Piece Bib Overall Set

What is this announcement about?

LT Apparel is announcing the voluntary recall of the Carhartt Infant 2-Piece Bib Overall Set due to a possible choking hazard involving the product's snaps, which may become loose. The style numbers for the recalled items include CG8500 (100 % cotton canvas overall with a 100% cotton knit short sleeve bodyshirt) and CG8501 (100 % cotton canvas overall with a 100% cotton knit short sleeve bodyshirt).

Where can I find the style number?

The style number can be found on the care label sewn on the inside of the garment.

Does this recall affect any other kids' overalls made by LT Apparel under Carhartt or any other brand names?

No. There are similar styles – with different style numbers – produced by LT Apparel under the Carhartt label, which are perfectly safe. That's why it is imperative for consumers to take note of the style number.

When were the items being recalled originally shipped to stores?

The items were originally shipped to stores throughout the US and Canada in February 2010.

What should I do if I have one of these recalled products?

Do not let your child wear the item. Instead, please call this number, 1-800-637-9035, and you will be sent a full refund, or return it to the retailer where you made the purchase and you will be given a full refund or store credit, whichever you prefer.

Does this recall include items sold outside of the US?

The product recall involves a total of 10,300 garments, 8,300 that were sold in the US and an additional 2,000 sold in Canada.

Have there been any injuries incurred as a result of the defective snaps?

No, there have been no reported incidents.
