LT Apparel Group Announces Voluntary Recall of Carhartt Infant 2-Piece Bib Overall Set

Company Recalls 10,300 Overall Sets Due To Possible Choking Hazard; No Injuries Reported

New York, NY – October 21, 2010 – LT Apparel Group, a leading manufacturer of children’s clothing, today announced the immediate voluntary recall of 10,300 Infant 2- Piece Bib Overall Sets that are sold under the Carhartt brand name. The recall was originally announced late on October 19 in a media statement from the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission and Health Canada.

The recall involves 8,300 Carhartt Infant 2-Piece Bib Overall Sets in the United States, and 2,000 Infant 2- Piece Bib Overall Sets in Canada being recalled for the risk of potential choking hazard in the event the snaps come loose. The style numbers include CG8500 (100 % cotton canvas overall with a 100% cotton knit short sleeve bodyshirt) and CG8501 (100 % cotton canvas overall with a 100% cotton knit short sleeve bodyshirt). The style number can be found on the care label sewn on the inside of the garment. The Infant 2-Piece Bib Overall Sets were sold in Carhartt brown or mineral red colors in infant sizes 3, 6, 9, 12, 18, and 24 months between February 2010 through July 2010 at participating retailers nationwide. No incidents or injuries have been reported.

Consumers should remove overalls from children’s reach and return them to the place of purchase for a full refund or store credit.
